

INVITATION TO BID WEC STALL DOORS

Notice. Notice is hereby given that the Agricultural District #3 Board is accepting bids to supply seventy-five (75) new stall doors at the Winnemucca Event Complex (WEC).

Specifications. The specifications, terms and conditions of the proposed purchase may be obtained from the office of the Director of Agricultural District #3 ("Ag 3"), Winnemucca Convention Center, 50 West Winnemucca Boulevard, Winnemucca, Nevada 89445, telephone (775) 623-5071 ext. 104, email: mike@winnemucca.com

Licensing-Qualifications. Bidders must: (i) must be authorized to do business in the State of Nevada and have the appropriate State of Nevada business license and local business license; (ii) be qualified pursuant to Nevada law to perform public entity contracts; and, (iii) if applicable, certify in the written contract compliance with subsection 4 of NRS 332.065.

Warranty. Bids must fully describe all applicable guarantees and/or warranties.

Proposal. Bids must be received not later than 3:00 o'clock p.m., Tuesday September 15, 2026 (using the Ag 3 Director's clock) and be clearly marked on the outside of a sealed envelope or in the email subject line:

Telegraph and telephone facsimile bids will not be accepted.

Withdrawal. Bids may be withdrawn by written notice received prior to the date and time set for receipt. Telegraph and facsimile withdrawals will not be accepted.

Consideration-Contract award. Review of the bids and contract award will be considered at a regular or special meeting of the Agricultural District #3 Board of Directors at the Winnemucca Convention Center on or after September 16, 2026, at a time to be announced, or as soon thereafter as the Ag 3 Board is able to consider the bids. A bid may be accepted at that time, subject to any additional approvals, and awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The lowest responsive and responsible bidder may be judged on the basis of: (a) price; (b) conformance to specifications; (c) bidder qualifications, such as possession of or limit on any required license, financial responsibility, experience and ability to perform the contract; (d) past performance; (e) adequacy of the bidder equipment; (f) performance schedule or delivery date; (g) the total cost of ownership of the equipment; (h) the purposes for which the equipment is required; (i) the history of maintenance and repair of the equipment; (j) the cost of routine maintenance and repair of the equipment; (k) any warranties provided in connection with the equipment; (l) the cost of replacement parts for the equipment; (m) the value of the equipment as used equipment when given in trade on a subsequent purchase; and (n) the best interests of the public. The right is reserved to waive any irregularities and/or informalities in the submitted bids, reject any and all bids or to accept the bid which is deemed by the Ag 3 Board to be in the best interest of the Agricultural District #3.
